

MOD/MCL Registration.

Please follow these steps to register for your 2013 – 2014 High School classes.

1. Log onto your Parent Portal account. This can be found at the Harrisburg School Website: <http://harrisburgdistrict42-1.org/> under the Parent-Public Tab.
2. If you do not have a parent portal account please call the school to set one up 743-2567.
3. Once logged onto your account you can choose the Course Registration 13-14 Harrisburg High School tab from the left hand column.
4. On the Course Registration page use the COURSE SEARCH Button to look up classes by Course Name or Course Number. The course numbers and class names are attached.
5. After entering a Course Name or Course Number hit Go. A list of Courses to review will pop up to the right. Chose the course that you are searching for by clicking on it.
6. A description of the course you chose may appear below the search field or a Request this Course button. Scroll down to read the description. For full course descriptions please refer to the course description book: http://highschool.harrisburgdistrict42-1.org/wp-content/uploads/2013/02/13-14_Reg_Course Offerings Book1.pdf
7. If this is your desired course select the Request this Course button. The class will now appear under your Requested Classes column. If the class is a year long be sure to register for both semesters (S1 and S2).
8. Repeat this process (Steps 4-7) until you have registered for all the classes you desire for next school year. We recommend registering for a minimum of 6 classes per semester (12 total for the year).

You may print out a copy of your class registration but this is not a necessity. The school will receive an electronic copy of your registration.

2013 – 2014 MOD/MCL Class Offerings

100 – 109 Levels

Classes are taught with modified/foundational pace, presentation and content. These classes are for students who may have difficulty in a subject and need more facilitation. These classes are graded on a modified scale of 3.667 or B+ on the traditional grading scale. A letter grade of “A” can be attained it will count 3.667 towards the students GPA.

110 – 119 Levels

Classes are taught at a standard pace, presentation and content in each subject area. These classes are graded on the traditional 4.0 grading scale.

150 – 159 Levels

Classes are Honors level and are taught at an advanced pace, presentation and content. Students registering for these classes should have been on the advanced track in this subject area or get a recommendation from prior teachers. In some cases required classes are necessary to take the class. These are Advanced level classes and are graded on a 4.2 grading scale.
